# What has changed?

### Key changes (or not) 1

- Population growth changed to +65,250
- MDRS grows properties to +73,400
- 3-waters report:
   Khandallah not ready
- New GW RTS standard is 10 trains per hour
- (No change to heritage)



# What has changed?

### Key changes (or not) 2

- JVL not an RTS,
   21m => 14m
- No SNAs on residential property
- Khandallah & Station Road corner are Local Centres
- MDRS front and side setbacks removed
- Local Centre can become mostly residential


